RESOLUTION R-23-02-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF OHATCHEE FOR THE USE OF FY-21 AND FY-22 ARPA FUNDS

WHEREAS: The Town of Ohatchee received ARPA funding from the State Department of Treasury in FY21 and FY22 totaling \$273,958.55 and;

WHEREAS: the Town could only utilize these funds for improvements to the water system, and;

WHEREAS: the town contracted with Utility Engineering Consultants, LLC and Baird Contracting Co. to upgrade all meters in the water system with AMR meters and associated software at a total cost of \$263,209.10 leaving a balance in the ARPA funds of \$10,749.45 and;

WHEREAS: the Water Dept. had Morrow Water Technologies, Inc. totally refurbish the Mohawk Bluff Dr. pump station during this period at a cost of \$11,084.62, the Town Council desires to reimburse the Water Dept. for this expense utilizing the remainder of the ARPA funding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OHATCHEE that the Mayor of Ohatchee is hereby authorized to transfer the remaining \$10,749.45 ARPA funds to the Ohatchee Water Dept. account.
